

PARKING IN OZ 3300

The resort OZ 3300 has been designed so that everyone can take full advantage of the facilities available while allowing our service providers to do their job. This way, everyone can enjoy their stay in Oz to the fullest!

Respecting the designated official car parks and times means:

- Facilitating access for emergency services, snowploughs, rubbish trucks, as well as vans and buses, so that they can continue to do their job.
- Making it easier for persons with reduced mobility to reach the ski resort.



Staying in Oz for a week? Parking in a more distant car park prevents traffic congestion around the centre and makes life easier for people parking temporarily.

PARKING VIOLATION

Owners of vehicles that do not respect the rules can be fined. The fines are €35 per day for obstructing parking and €135 per day for improperly occupying a space reserved for persons with reduced mobility.

ASK YOUR CHALET OWNER

Are you staying in an apartment or chalet in Oz? Contact your accommodation owner to find out if he or she has parking spaces available for you during your stay.

COVERED PARKING LE ROUBIER

The Roubier underground car park is close to the centre of the resort. Entry cards for a week are on sale (50€) at the tourist office. For any information, the Tourist Office is at your disposal on 0033 4 76 80 78 01.

WINTER TYRES AND CHAINS COMPULSORY



To improve traffic safety in winter and to limit the blocking of roads in the mountain regions, it is compulsory since 2021, to equip your vehicle with chains or socks (at least on the two driven wheels) or with 4 snow tyres, from 1st November to 31st March.

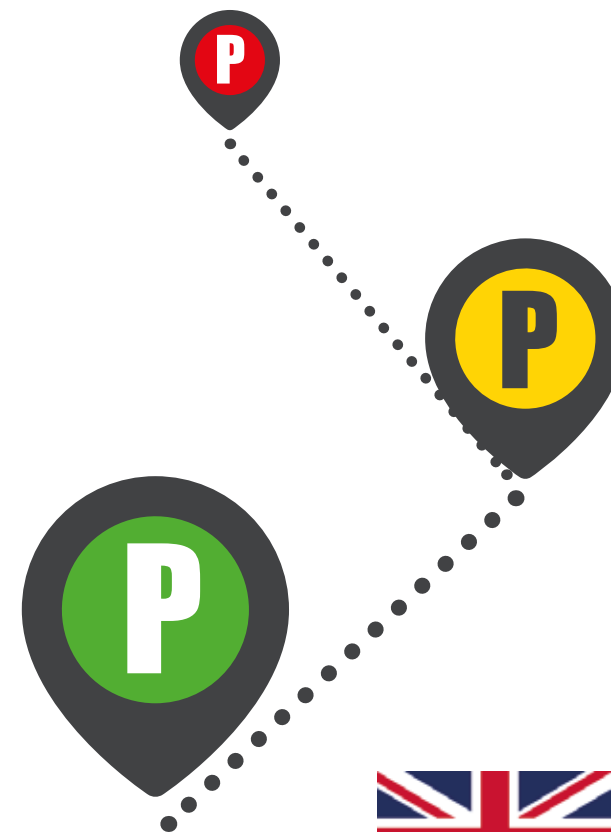
BUSSES/SHUTTLES

The Grenoble bus station is located next to the SNCF train station and the arrival station for buses from the airport of Grenoble, Chambéry, Geneva & Lyon St Exupéry.

DIRECT bus : Transaltitude line with reservation
Grenoble <-> Oz Station : www.transaltitude.fr
BUS WITH CORRESPONDENCE: Daily bus service between Grenoble and Rochetaillée : Transisère T75 line to Rochetaillée (10 km from Oz), then link with Allemond (7 km from Oz) : Transisère T70 line (on demand), stop 'Plan Barbier' then Eau d'Olle Express lift to Oz station.

1 PARKING LES CHENEVIERS

200 spaces. Parking for a week, season and camper vans.
8 minutes by foot to Alpette lift and 7 minutes to Poutran.

2 PARKING LE RELAIS

64 spaces. 7 minutes by foot to Alpette lift.

3 PARKING LES COTES

54 spaces. 7 minutes by foot to Alpette lift.

4 PARKING MYANS

24 spaces. 6 minutes by foot to Alpette lift.

5 PARKING LA PIERRE

43 spaces. 4 minutes by foot to Alpette lift.

6 PARKING ALPETTE

20 spaces. 1 minute by foot to Alpette lift and 4 min. to Poutran.

7 PARKING LE SAUGET

18 spaces, 4 drop-off spaces, 2 PRM spaces.
1 minute by foot to Alpette lift and 4 min. to Poutran.

8 PARKING LES SORBIERS

50 spaces. 4 minutes by foot to Alpette and Poutran lift

9 PARKING L'OLMET

18 spaces, 2 drop-off spaces et 4 PRM spaces.
1 minute by foot to Poutran and 3 minutes to Alpette.

10 PARKING POUTRAN

70 spaces of which 4 PRM spaces..
2 minutes by foot to Poutran lift and 5 minutes to Alpette.

11 PARKING LA PAQUES

40 spaces. 3 minutes by foot to Poutran lift.

12 UNDERGROUND PARKING LE ROUBIER

299 spaces of which 4 PRM. Long stay/ week parking.
Entry cards (50 €) are on sale at the tourist office.
2 minutes by foot to Poutran lift and 5 to Alpette lift.

bus BUS PARKING

14 spaces for busses. 4 minutes by foot to Poutran and Alpette lift.
